

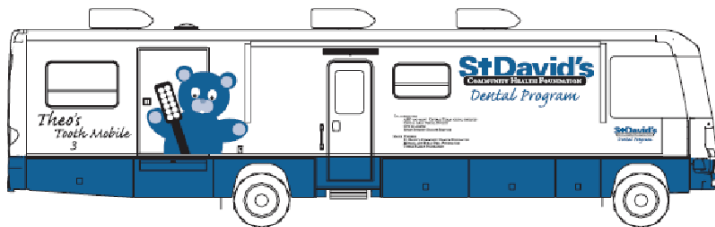

Get Involved!

Here are five easy ways to becoming active as a volunteer with the mobile dental program.

- 1. We need volunteer providers to help us continue the connection of dental care beyond the mobile clinic.** Occasionally we encounter patients who require treatment beyond the scope of care that we can deliver on the mobile clinics. By volunteering your dental services in your office setting, you can help restore a child’s smile or enable an adult to return to work.
Note: Our dental program will pay for lab fees associated with this volunteer service.
- 2. Sign up to volunteer on the mobile clinic,** along with your dental assistant. As much as possible, we will coordinate your visit when the clinic is at a site that is convenient for you.
- 3. Assist with fundraising for the program.** It costs us thousands of dollars in supplies to offer care in the community. St. David’s Community Health Foundation has developed a mail campaign that promotes your involvement with the dental program to your patients and gives them the opportunity to make a financial gift.
- 4. Consider donations of toothbrushes or toothpaste** as our health education program offers brushing instructions to thousands of children a year.
- 5. Treat an Austin musician.** In many cases, through the MusiCares program, we can refer one of our musician patients to you for extended care, and you will be reimbursed.
